# **Duration of internship**

The internship programme shall be for persons who have completed their training and graduated. The internship period shall be for a period of six (6) months renewable once for a further period not exceeding six (6) months.

## **Eligibility for Internship**

This will include:

- 1. Unemployed Kenyan graduates from training institutions who have completed their degree courses and have not been exposed to work experience related to their area of study.
- 2. Graduates of programmes for whom internship is a requirement for registration by their respective professional bodies.

#### **Terms of Offer**

Interested candidates who meet the above requirements are requested to submit the following:

- 1. An application letter clearly indicating the reference number for the Division/Section in which they are applying;
- 2. A detailed resume stating their qualifications, names and addresses of three referees, email and telephone contacts
- 3. Copies of academic/professional certificates
- 4. Copy of National Identity card
